THE WORLD ORGANISATION OF JEWISH DEAF RECORD

The World Organisation of Jewish Deaf was established at the Helen Keller Center, Tel Aviv, Israel in the spring of 1973 when several jewish deaf leaders from various nations expressed a desire to upgrade the educational, communication, social welfare and religious needs of the Jewish deaf and foster Judaism world-wide. Leading advocates for this movement were Chaim Apter, Moshe Bamberger, Moshe Shem-Tov of Israel, Emil and Jane Shryker of Great Britain, Bernard Baran and Maurice Sebban of France and Alexander Fleischman of USA.

The initial goal was to pattern the Organization of international level with the home office situated in Israel and to convene every four years where persons of note present papers on various topics pertaining to the Jewish deaf. The 1st Congress took place at the Pal Hotel in Tel Aviv and the 2nd Congress convened at Binyanei Ha'ooma Convention Center in Jerusalem. At both Congresses the honorable Chief Rabbi of Israel, Shlomo Goren, was the keynoter.

In 1984, the W.O.J.D. became mobile by staging a conference in London, hosted by Jewish Deaf Association. This enabled other professional people to present their views on the objectives of the W.O.J.D.

WORLD ORGANISATION OF JEWISH DEAF AIMS

1. To take an awareness of the activities and progress of affiliated Jewish organizations of the deaf and/or needs in nations where small number of Jewish deaf reside.
2. To establish scientific commissions on religion, education, communication, social welfare.
3. To concentrate on youth programs such as sports, art and culture, leadership training, deaf carcus, world wide network.
4. To improve its public relations drive among the Jewish hearing disapora and organizations to spread the cause of Jewish deaf and work in unity.
5. To establish a periodical in which Jewish deaf organizations, individuals and interested hearing persons will be kept informed of movements and general topics.
6. To be involved with the promotion of Judaism and coordinate with rabbinical seminaries and rabbinical organizations better understanding about the Jewish deaf.
7. To search for and enduce capable deaf persons to study for the rabbinate.

WOJD BRANCH MEETING
held at JDA- LONDON, 26th June 1988.

Sid Maxwell opened the meeting with a recap of what he had set down in his report that had been circulated to all members of JDA in June/July newsletter, with extra items as belows:

ELECTION: The Israeli delegates proposed Sid Maxwell as a presidential-candidate of WOJD, but lost to Dr. Alan Hurwitz.

FINANCES: It must be emphasised that the Association of the Deaf in Israel pays 80% of the WOJD expenses, it is getting too much of a burden for one country's Jewish deaf community to contribute so much for the good of the World Jewish Deaf. It has been proposed to raise U.S. \$50 affiliation fee per country or organisation to U.S. \$100 per year, subject to the approval of all organisations, in worldwide, concerned.

WOJD CONSTITUTION: The signing of the new statute had to be postponed due to many objections mainly from England. Therefore the old constitution will remain on force while the committee is to be set up to draw up a new one.

PUBLICITY AND COMMUNICATION: S. Maxwell had a look at the WOJD records in Israel during 1986 to find out as to why the WOJD were not better known to the World Jewish Deaf. The failure was mainly in the failure in publicity and communications. Hopefully the new committee on publicity and communications will revitalise these two important items. It is to be hoped to have electronic communication link-ups between countries, so as to speed up communications between the various clubs and organisations.

WOJD CONVENTION 1992: S. Maxwell will go to Paris in 1989 to check on the suitability of Paris as the venue for the 1992 Convention. As it is known, that the two French-Jewish Deaf Clubs are still poles apart and there is nothing that we can do about it.

BOARD AND BUREAU: There seems to be overlapping and duplication in the set up of these two groups. However the function of the Board is to make decisions and pass them to the Bureau for implementation. It has been agreed that individual membership fee is to go up to U.S. \$5 per year (i.e. from 1st January to 31st December).

U.S.A. : There are about 20 Jewish Deaf Club-Organisations in USA, they refuse to pay U.S. \$50 affiliation fee each to the WOJD, claiming that their umbrella organisation, National Congress of Jewish Deaf, known as NCJD should pay a single fee of U.S. \$50 per year to cover all of them. The law and statue committee will have to work out a tactful way of dealing with this matter, bearing in mind that they have two delegates to the WOJD. Also, there are approximately 500,000 persons of varying hearing disabilities; if, and it is only just an "IF", they, in each, were paying U.S. \$5 membership fee, then it would be, definitely, a great help to the WOJD financial budget.

OTHER ITEMS: It must be remembered that Emil Stryker is the Founder of WOJD. East Berlin, East-Germany and Hungary have small Jewish deaf communities. Publicity and literatures will be sent to all Jewish deaf clubs and organisations around the world for the benefit of their Jewish Deaf members.

Jonathan Sterne regretted that he was the only individual person at the 3rd WOJD Convention from England and South Africa, whilst people came from USA, France, Australia, Germany, Hungary, etc.

Rev. Plaskow was asked to present a paper on the problem of the Jewish Deaf in the sphere of religion. The WOJD was impressed and interested in his work in getting the attention of synagogues to install loops-system and with the possibility of sign-language interpreters to attend in their buildings, so that the hearing-impaired and the deaf could participate more fully in the services. What is most surprising is that while one aim of the WOJD is to improve the awareness of the Jewish faith among the Jewish Deaf; there are no rabbis and religious officials in Israel who could communicate with the Jewish Deaf on their own. As England and USA do already have such officials.....Why?
